CUBE; BATTERY TEST PROCEDURE RECOMMENDATION

APPLIED VEHICLES: 2009 Cube (Z12)

SERVICE INFORMATION

The following procedures **MUST** be followed in order to correctly test the Cube battery. Failure to follow these procedures may result in incorrect battery test/check result.

When testing batteries with the Midtronics GR8 select Model (from drop down list) and appropriate CCA will be selected automatically.

NOTE: If the Midtronics Update Wizard has not been done recently, the Cube will not appear on the Model drop down list ⁽¹⁾

IMPORTANT: If you do choose to manually input CCA for testing the Cube, you **MUST** use the following specifications:

- Cube **Original Equipment (OE)** battery is **356 CCA**.
- Cube **Service (replacement)** battery is **550 CCA**.

NOTE: DO NOT test the OE battery with the Service battery specifications. If incorrect CCA is used GR8 may incorrectly fail a good battery.

⁽¹⁾ To run the Midtronics Update Wizard for the GR8 tester in CONSULT III:

- a. Make sure the cables from the GR8 to the multitasker are connected and both units are turned on.
- b. Click on the ASIST icon.
- c. Click on INFO. Tool Box.
- d. Select Midtronics GR8.
- e. Midtronics Update Wizard file screen displays.
- f. Click on Change MUP File.
- g. The Select a MUP file window displays with the path:
C:\ProgramFiles\Midtronics\MUW.
- h. Select 192-725C and click OK.
- i. Click on next and follow the prompts on the Midtronics Update Wizard screen.
